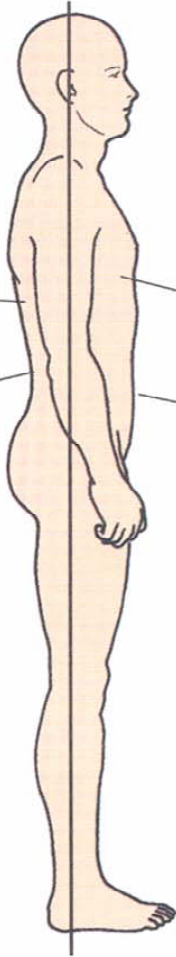

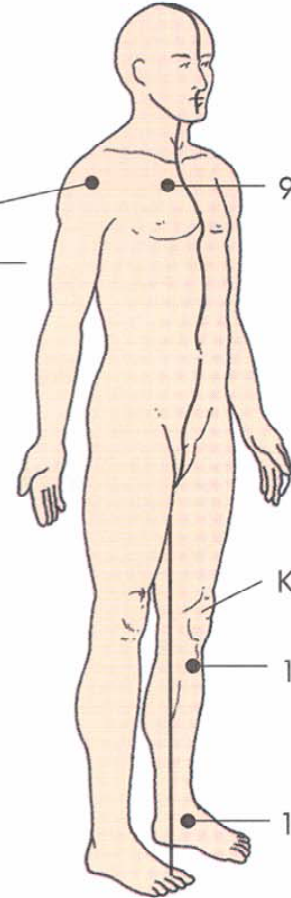

4. The **HYPOCHONDRIAC** regions are to the right and left of the epigastric region.
5. Superior to the hypogastric region is the **UMBILICAL** region.
6. To the right and left of the umbilical region are the **LUMBAR** regions.
